



Service Animals & Pets at Eckert's

At Eckert's, we are committed to providing a welcoming and enjoyable experience for all guests.

Service Animals

In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), trained service animals are welcome throughout Eckert's, including our Country Stores, Restaurant, Pick-Your-Own Orchards, Food Service Areas, and outdoor attractions.

A service animal is a dog (or, in some cases, a trained miniature horse) that has been individually trained to perform specific tasks for a person with a disability. Service animals do not need to wear a vest or carry certification to be recognized under the ADA.

For the comfort and safety of all guests, service animals must remain under their handler's control at all times. While accompanying their handler, service animals should remain on the floor and may not sit on tables, chairs, benches, counters, or ride in shopping carts.

They should not be fed at restaurant tables.

Emotional Support Animals

Emotional support, comfort, therapy, and companion animals are not considered service animals under the ADA and are not permitted inside our Country Stores or restaurants.

Pets

Well-behaved pets are welcome in our outdoor areas, including the Cider Shed and Pick-Your-Own fields.

To help protect our crops and ensure a positive experience for all guests, pets and emotional support animals are welcome in the orchards but are not permitted to walk down rows of strawberries or blackberries.

Pets are not permitted inside our Country Stores or restaurants in accordance with food safety regulations.
